If by train you can use the Greater Anglia train to Meridian Water station which can be picked up from Tottenham Hale or Stratford once at the station come out of the station entrance turn right, down the flight of stairs and follow the path and it will lead to the skills academy on the left.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

The skills learnt include, general math skills, subtracting, multiply, division, addition, ordering materials, checking your payslip, measuring, working out angles, ratios, fractions and time.

WHAT WILL I NEED?

Please be prepared to provide your residency documents such as a passport, EU citizen ID card, UK Birth Certificate or Biometric Card. If you have been in the UK for less than 1 years or have entered the UK with a visa you will need to provide evidence that you are eligible to study in the UK - your visa, your biometric card that covers the duration of your course or any relevant home office documents to support your residency should all be provided. If you're an EU, EEA or Swiss citizen we will need to see evidence of 'Pre-Settled' or 'Settled-status' documents. Also for funding purposes we would need to see evidence of payslips if working (within the last 3 months). If you are receiving benefits (e.g JSA, ESA, Universal Credit (UC), Housing benefits etc. please provide evidence of this).

WHAT CAN I DO AFTER?
