If you have been in the UK for less than 1 year or have entered the UK with a visa you will need to provide evidence that you are eligible to study in the UK - your visa, your biometric card that covers the duration of your course or any relevant home office documents to support your residency should all be provided.

If you're an EU, EEA or Swiss citizen we will need to see evidence of 'Pre-Settled' or 'Settled-status' documents.

Also, for funding purposes, we would need to see evidence of payslips if working (within the last 3 months). If you are receiving benefits (e.g. JSA, ESA, Universal Credit (UC), Housing benefits etc. please provide evidence of this).

On completion of this course, you can progress onto further study in this field and use your new language skills to communicate to others in Spanish
