







Costume and Wardrobe Roles - Introduction (Creative Skills Academy)

This masterclass aims to give students a comprehensive understanding of costume design and the various roles within a wardrobe department. Participants will learn about the creative and practical aspects of costume design, the responsibilities of wardrobe professionals, and gain hands-on experience in key skills.

This course will provide students with a solid foundation in costume design and wardrobe management, combining theoretical knowledge with practical skills to prepare them for future roles in theatre, film and live events.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

This 1-day session will cover:

- Introduction to key roles: Wardrobe Supervisor, Costume Assistant, Dresser and more
- The creative process: from script analysis to final design
- Importance of historical accuracy, character development and storytelling through costumes
- · Sources of inspiration: historical texts, artwork, fashion trends and cultural references
- Creating mood boards and concept sketches
- Essential tools and materials used in costume design
- Techniques for sketching, fabric selection and pattern making
- Techniques for measuring, fitting and making alterations
- Best practices for costume maintenance and care
- Managing costume inventory and storage
