

Nail Technology - Level 2 Diploma

Nail technology is a growing area in the UK, with the average British woman spending £450 on their nails each year, and visiting a nail salon at least twice a month. This nail technology course introduces the nail care and enhancement section of the beauty therapy sector, teaching basic skills in areas such as manicures, pedicures, and nail art.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Topics covered can include:

- Manicure and pedicure services
- Gel polish
- Anatomy and physiology for hands and feet
- Introduction to working in the nail industry
- Nail enhancements
- Nail art services
- Employer engagement activities
- Health and safety
- Client care
- Salon reception duties
- Promote and retail products/services
- Eye treatments, make-up and tanning opportunities
- Creating an image

WHAT WILL I NEED?

You will need:

- Four GCSEs at grade 3 or above or a relevant Level 1 qualification

All applicants must have an initial assessment and interview to confirm that the course is suitable for them.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

You will be assessed through a portfolio of evidence, collected from written assessments, presentations, witness statements and practice observation.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

AGED 16-18

ADULTS - ENTRY LEVEL, LEVEL 1 AND LEVEL 2

If you will be aged 19+ on 31st August prior to the start date of your course, up to Level 2, then your study with us will be free. You must have lived for 3 years within the EU/EEA/UK prior to the start of your course, you must have lived in the UK before 1st January 2021 and you must have permission to live in the UK for at least 12 months from the first day of learning.
