The Sewing Machinist plays a vital role in the production process across various sectors within the industry. This programme will enable you to gain skills knowledge and behaviours to work in the fashion and textile manufacturing industry.

You will be taught specific sewing machinist skills that will enable you to work with a wide range of sewn products including clothing, leather goods, medical textiles, soft furnishings and aviation textiles. You will often work as part of a team and contribute to the overall success of the production output. You will complete quality checks prepare materials and complete work records. You will contribute to a sustainable culture by minimising waste and recycling.

- Work efficiently in work both individual and team settings.
- Be ambitious to excel in all tasks.
- Have ownership in tasks, recognising the value of one's role and others.
- Understand the commitment to maintaining quality and efficiency standards.
- Be adaptable to changing work environments and demands.

- Be punctual and reliable, understanding the impact of absence or lateness.
- Prioritise safety in sewing production and broader work environment.
