It will prepare you to use your knowledge of standard operating procedures and legal requirements to provide a safe and hygienic environments for service users.

END POINT ASSESSMENT

The EPA runs over 3 months and includes a knowledge test (computer based), an observation, and a structured interview.

Pass and Distinction grades can be obtained.
