WHAT WILL I STUDY?

WHAT WILL I NEED?

You will need:

- Four GCSEs at grade 2 or above, including GCSE English Language and Maths
- An Enhanced DBS check
- A reference from your previous school/college

All applicants must have an interview and assessment to confirm that the course is suitable for them.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

The course is assessed throughout the year and with an end-of-course portfolio.
