Business - Level 3 National Extended Diploma

This course develops the knowledge, understanding and skills you'll need to follow your career pathway in Business. You will work closely with employers, namely Samsung, and Google, and local charities such as the Local Village network, who are integrated into the assessment process, giving you the essential skills to get you ready for the world of work, higher education, apprenticeships, and internships. You will be taught, Digital Marketing, Finance, Law, Events, and Enterprise for those of you wanting to start your own business.

All applicants must have an interview to confirm that the course is suitable for them.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

Assessment is carried out by completing an employer-linked project, and core unit exams which embed all units related to the course. The project is graded by achieving each task set out in the assignment brief. You will work closely with an employer brief which includes both theoretical and practical topics. This will give you both transferable practical skills and the theoretical ability to enhance your employability status with the purpose of recognising your ability to integrate the knowledge and skills gained on the course.

WHAT WILL IT COST?
