Applied Science - Level 2

Do you have an interest in research? discovering how diseases are caused or why we behave the way we do?

This course offers a mixture of hands-on practical activities, industry visits and theory of science. Studying this course will provide you with the experience that will develop your skills and knowledge, and the confidence to progress towards higher-level study in one of the sciences - applied, health, medical or forensic sciences.

Gaining the Level 2 qualification will allow you to investigate different science careers, learners will complete practicals into understanding human behaviour, study ecosystems and have the chance to complete their own mini-research project.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

In Level 2 you will study a range of scientific topics taught by our specialists some of the topics covered can include:

- Chemistry and our Earth
- Energy and our Universe
- Biology and our Environment
- Understanding Human Behaviour

Alongside practising your practicals skills, we explore experiments in Chemistry, Physics and Biology.

WHAT WILL I NEED?

You will need:

- To be aged 16 to 18
- Four GCSEs at grade 3 or above, including English Language, Maths and Science or a Level 1 Diploma in Science, with Functional Skills in Maths and English at Level 1

All applicants must have an interview and assessment to confirm that the course is suitable for them.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

Assessment is continuous throughout the year, this course provides a mixture of completing written assignments and projects as well as and performing practical work that is assessed internally within the college allowing you to experiment with all assessment styles. There will also be some written examinations, assessed externally via Pearson, the BTEC awarding body.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

AGED 16-18

If you will be aged 16, 17 or 18 on 31st August prior to the start date of your course and you have the legal right to remain in the UK for the duration of your programme then your study with us will be free. Please see <u>here</u> for the documents you will need to show us.
