Health and Social Care - Level 2 Certificate

This is a one-year Level 2 Health and Social Care qualification. The course is aimed at learners who are over 19 years old and wish to enter into a career pathway within the care sector.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Units you will study:

- Human Growth and Development
- Safeguarding and Protection in Health and Social Care
- Equality, Diversity and Rights in Health and Social Care

WHAT WILL I NEED?

There are no specific entry requirements, needed for this course. However, learners may find it beneficial to have completed level 1 in Health and Social Care prior to enrolling on this course. A minimum of level 1 in literacy is necessary for the completion of the assessed work completion.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

Assessment is through coursework that is spread out throughout the first two terms.

Learners will also be required to complete a minimum of 30 hours within an industry placement. Our team will support you in finding a suitable placement setting.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

ADULTS - ENTRY LEVEL, LEVEL 1 AND LEVEL 2

If you will be aged 19+ on 31st August prior to the start date of your course, up to Level 2, then your study with us will be free. You must have lived for 3 years within the EU/EEA/UK prior to the start of your course, you must have lived in the UK before
