

Public Services - Level 2 Diploma

This course will advance your knowledge of public services, including the army and police force, helping you to advance to further study or employment in the sector. Our teachers come from a variety of different uniformed services, and we have strong links with many large employers, giving you access to a wide range of activities and trips, which will give you valuable insight into the types of careers available.

Fitness is a major element of our public services courses, preparing you for selection tests within the armed forces or police force. You will also learn communication and English skills, which are essential so that you can communicate with members of the public and write up notes and reports. Maths skills are also embedded into the course, helping you to read maps, perform compass work and undertake team planning.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Topics covered can include:

- Improving Health and Fitness for Entry into Uniformed Service
- Practical Teamwork in Public Services
- Personal Skills for Public Service
- Functional Skills in English and Maths

WHAT WILL I NEED?

You will need:

- Four GCSEs at grade 3 or above or a relevant Level 1 Diploma
- A reference from your previous school/college, with an attendance record of 87% or above

All applicants must have an interview and assessment to confirm that the course is suitable for them.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

Assessment is by coursework throughout the course.

ADULTS - ENTRY LEVEL, LEVEL 1 AND LEVEL 2

If you will be aged 19+ on 31st August prior to the start date of your course, up to Level 2, then your study with us will be free. You must have lived for 3 years within the EU/EEA/UK prior to the start of your course, you must have lived in the UK before 1st January 2021 and you must have permission to live in the UK for at least 12 months from the first day of learning.
