#### WHAT WILL I NEED?

You will need

• Level 2 Qualification in Health Care

#### or

• Level 1 Functional Skills in English and are working towards your Level 2

#### HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

This qualification is internally assessed and externally quality assured.

The assessment consists of two components:

- An internally assessed portfolio of evidence which is assessed by centre staff and externally quality assured by NCFE
- An assessed Observation conducted in a work/placement setting (Learners will need to be working, volunteering or on practical placement)

# WHAT WILL IT COST?

### AGED 16-18

If you will be aged 16, 17 or 18 on 31st August prior to the start date of your course and you have the legal right to remain in the UK for the duration of your programme then your study with us will be free. Please see here for the documents you will need to show us.

Otherwise, you will have to pay the fees yourself or apply for an <u>Advanced Learner Loan</u>.
